Entrepreneurs must be willing and able to work out of the accelerator's co-working space (221-181 Keefer Place, Vancouver) for a 12-month period (Jan 2015 – Dec 2015) and participate in all program activities.

To apply for the Coast Capital Savings Innovation Hub accelerator program, please submit the following by email to joanna.buczowska@sauder.ubc.ca **no later than November 5, 2014:**

- A PowerPoint deck/PDF (maximum 10 slides) giving an overview of your venture
 - Make sure your presentation includes information about: the social/environmental problem you are addressing and how your product/service aims to solve it, your revenue model, your value proposition, plans for how you plan to scale your venture to create more impact, milestones you have reached to date, and what your venture needs now to move forward.

- A financial summary
 - Past financial statements (if available)
 - Financial plan for the next 3 years (Projected income statement)

- Answers to the following questions (maximum 200 words per question)
 - What led you start a social venture and how did you identify the social/environmental problem your venture addresses?

 - How do you think you would most benefit from being part of the accelerator (what resources could you benefit from most) and what could you contribute to the accelerator?

 - What do you expect to be your biggest challenge in the next 12 months?
