1. Enterprise Systems and Cloud-Based Applications

- 1.1 Incorporated SAP ERP and SAP Business ByDesign (cloud-based ERP system) into the course curriculum of COMM 335 (Information System Technology and Development) and BUSI 335 (Information Systems).
- 1.2 Incorporated NetSuite (cloud-based ERP system) into the course curriculum of COMM 391/ COMM 205 (Introduction to Management Information Systems).
- 1.3 Incorporated FileMaker Pro (database management system) into the course curriculum of COMM 205 (Introduction to Management Information Systems).
- 1.4 Incorporated Tableau Desktop (data visualization software) into the course curriculum of COMM 335 (Information System Technology and Development) and COMM 205 (Introduction to Management Information Systems).

2. Network Technology and Security

- 2.1 Acquired, installed and configured a new virtual server based on VMWare vSphere Server to enable students to conduct research on web-based network applications including workflow processing, shared BI dashboard, web database services, etc. to support various business processes and functions.
- 2.2 Designed and incorporated a series of projects into the course curriculum of COMM 439 (Business Telecommunications) to enable students to gain hands-on experience in building virtual network servers, intranets, and setting up network firewalls and virtual private networks.
- 2.3 Created a virtual server environment with over 70 virtual machines based on VMWare vSphere Server to enable students to work on their network development projects outside the computer labs.
- 2.4 Prepared and updated the course materials and project requirements for the network development and system administration projects for COMM 439 based on the virtual server environment.
- 2.5 Created a new virtual server environment and set up over 150 virtual machines on the UBC EduCloud to enable students to work on their network development projects. The software installed include Microsoft Windows 2012, 2008 and 2003 Server, Internet Information Services, SharePoint Server, Internet Security & Acceleration Server 2006 (firewall), Windows 7, RedHat Enterprise Linux Server, Apache server and MySQL database server.

3. E-Business Application Development and Open Source Software
 - 3.1 Installed and managed the MS Windows servers for web database application development and conducted testing of Microsoft ASP.NET AJAX (Asynchronous JavaScript and XML) based on ASP.NET 2.0 and Microsoft Visual Studio 2005 for COMM 435.
 - 3.2 Installed a new Linux server and conducted testing of the web database development using Apache server, MySQL database and PHP for COMM 435.
 - 3.3 Prepared and updated the course materials and project requirements for the web database development projects for COMM 435.
4. Redesign of COMM 391 (COMM 205) - Introduction to Management Information Systems
 - 4.1 Redesigned the learning outcomes and course structure of COMM 391 (COMM 205) with more emphasis on the systematic approach to improving a company's business processes and data governance using technologies.
 - 4.2 Revised the course materials and project requirements for COMM 391 (COMM 205) based on the new Enterprise IT Model - SMAC (Social, Mobile, Analytics and Cloud).
 - 4.3 Designed a database assignment for COMM 205 based on FileMaker Pro (a database software for Windows and Mac).
