

Employer FAQ

What are the hourly requirements of the internship?

- The internship must be of 480 hours in length which equates to approximately 30 hours per week for 4 months. Depending on the start date and the actual hours worked per week, the students can complete their hourly requirement part-time into the next academic term.

How do employers pay their \$2,500 contribution?

- MITACS will invoice the company once the application has been approved.

How will students be paid?

- UBC Sauder will be paying the students directly. Mitacs will be invoicing the employer and reimbursing UBC Sauder for the outstanding amount.

Do international students qualify for this fund?

- Yes, international students do qualify for this federal fund.

Can the internship be longer than 480 hours?

- Individual Internships through this fund are limited to 480 hours per student. Employers can make additional fund applications for multiple student hires.

Is there a maximum amount of payment that each student can receive?

- Each student can receive up to a maximum of \$10,000 funding from the Business Strategy Internship fund.
